


## with End Quotation Marks



Do you know the French words to "Are You Sleeping?"

Were you there when she shouted, "What an ugly painting!"

You don't need an extra question mark here.

2. Is the sentence a question or exclamatory? And does it lack a question mark or exclamation point at the end of the quote or title? If yes to both, then the question mark or exclamation point goes on the OUTSIDE of the end quotation mark.

Do you have my copy of Francis Bacon's essay "Of Travel"?

Did he really say, "I'm going to buy you a new car"?

I was shocked when I read "The Lottery"! 4

With no question mark or exclamation point in the quotation marks, the question mark or exclamation point goes at the very end.
