7. You've just found out that you're moving across the country. Write a letter describing how it feels settling in to your new place.

9. Share about the day we first became friends.
10. Describe what it would be like if we were siblings instead of friends.
11. Write a [diamante poem](#) about our friendship.
12. Write a prayer for our friendship.

14. We each have a twin. Our twins aren't yet friends with one another. Describe how you might encourage the friendship.
15. I've decided to make a large purchase while shopping. You think it's a bad idea. How would you persuade me to rethink my decision to buy?
